CONFESSIO OF SIN (kneeling, if able)

† CONFESSIO OF FAITH Heidelberg Catechism Qs. 120 - 121

People: These words teach us not to think of God’s heavenly majesty as something earthly, and teach us to expect everything needed for body and soul from God’s almighty power.

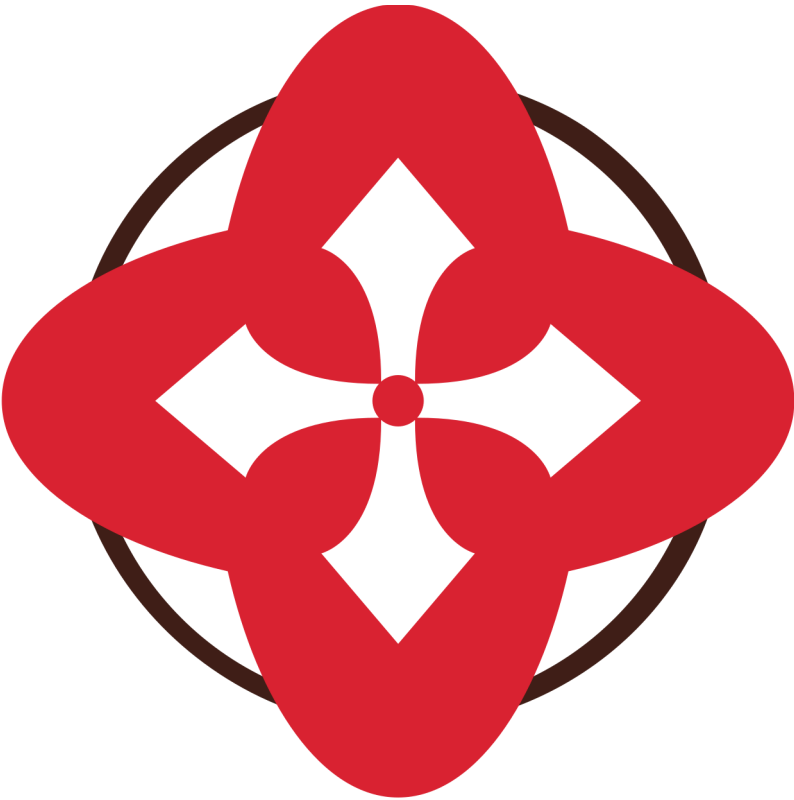
